## VISION

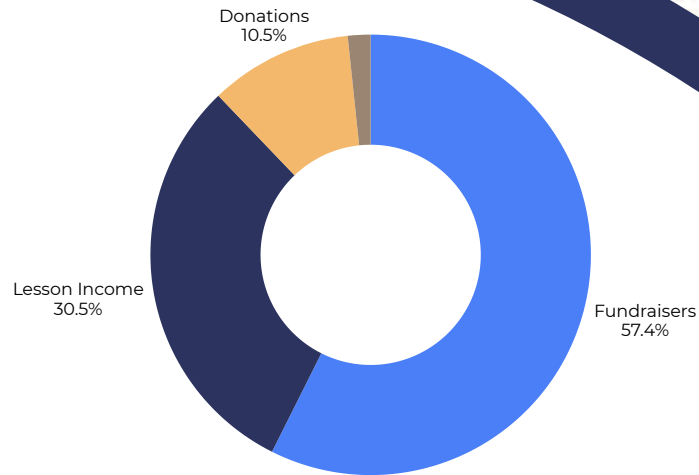

To provide individuals with special abilities in the community the opportunity to experience the physical, emotional, and social benefits of interacting with equines.

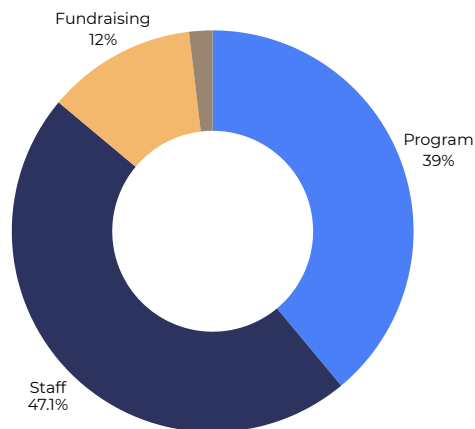

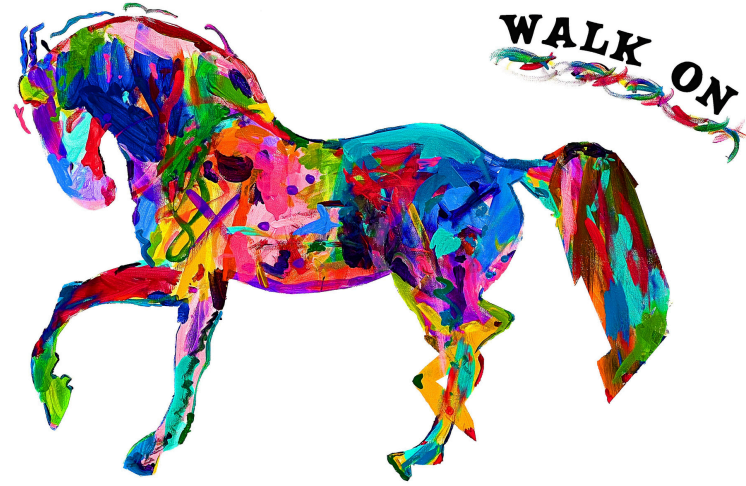
